Is your entering kindergartner able to?

- State full name and age
- Take care of ALL toilet needs
- Remove and put on outerwear
- Open/Close snaps, buttons, zippers
- Follow directions
- Repeat directions
- Separate easily from parent
- Respect/obey teachers in the classroom
- Listen to a 15 minute story
- Work at one activity for 10 – 15 minutes
- Recognize colors
- Use crayons for coloring and scissors for cutting
- Count to 10
- Take turns/share
- Speaks clearly to identify needs

Remember the child who begins school when he or she is developmentally ready is most likely to have a successful experience.
